

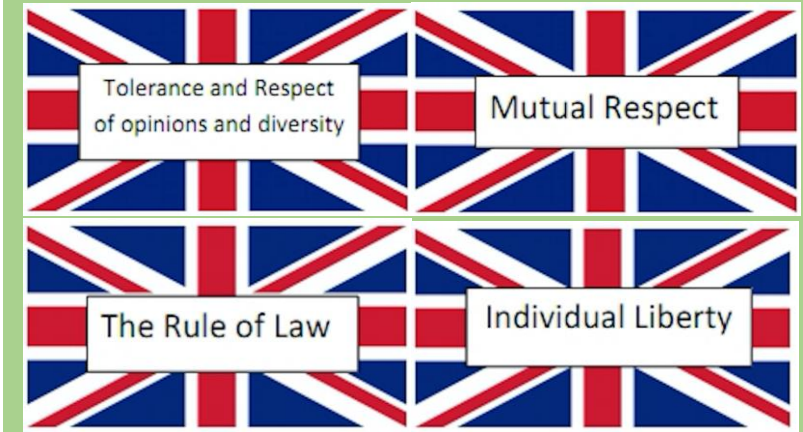

Vocabulary	Definition
similarities	a sameness or likeness.
differences	a point or way in which people or things are dissimilar
ethnicity	a sense of identity and membership in a group that shares common language, cultural traits (values, beliefs, religion, food habits, customs, etc.), and a sense of a common history
faith	strong belief in a religion, based on spiritual conviction
culture	the ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society
gender	male/female
stereotypes	a widely held but fixed and oversimplified image or idea of a particular type of person or thing
assumptions	accepted as true or as certain to happen, without proof
