What can people do to protect the environment?

Vocabulary	Definition
responsibility	something that it is your job or duty to deal with
choices	an act of choosing between two or more possibilities.
environment	the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.
Fairtrade	trade between companies in developed countries and producers in developing countries in which fair prices are paid to the producers.
single use plastics	goods used once, or for a short period of time, before being thrown away
facts	a thing that is known or proved to be true.
Thoughts/opinions	a view or judgement formed about something, not necessarily based on fact or knowledge.
donate	give (money or goods) for a good cause, for example to a charity.
