

English

This term, children will look at a range of **Novel as a Theme and Non-Chronological reports**. Children will begin by writing their own short story based on ideas from the story 'Gulliver's Travels', developing our writing using prepositions and adverbs.

Through shared reading, we will explore the opening to the story. Model the use of intonation, expression and use of punctuation to aid effective reading aloud

Science

Children learn that materials and objects can be grouped into solids, liquids and gases. They look at the properties of solids, liquids and gases and relate these to the common uses of materials. Children look at the water cycle and build on their understanding of evaporation and condensation.

DT

Children will plan a sequence of actions to make a money container. They will record the plan by drawing using annotated sketches.

Maths

We will continue to develop our **fractions and decimals**, and **begin to look at length involving perimeter**. It is important that we continue to **expand our Times tables'** knowledge, which will help us in our Multiplication and Division unit of work.



Physical Education

During P.E Children will dribble effectively into space by using their feet. They will avoid collisions with others while dribbling and will be able to apply pressure to an attacker to successfully tackle them.



Geography

Children will name at least 5 European countries and major cities. They will describe two similarities and differences between a chosen area of Europe and life in the UK.
