**Why is it important to care for humans/animals and our planet?**

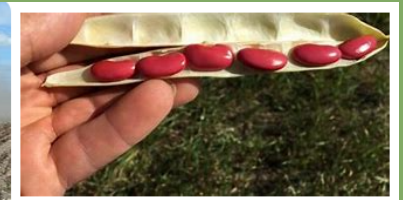
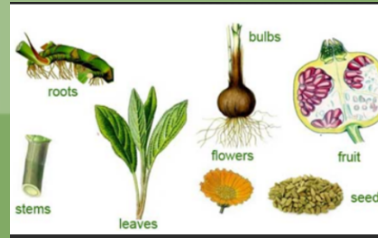
So we can all live in harmony and create a sustainable future.

**Vocabulary**      **Definition**

<b>fruit</b>	a part of a plant that can be eaten and contains seeds
<b>vegetable</b>	a part of a plant that can be eaten, such as a stem, root or leaf
<b>parts of a plant</b>	Seed, root, stem, leaves, flower
<b>farmer</b>	a person who grows crops
<b>crops</b>	living plants grown by farmers
<b>helpful action</b>	an action that is useful to a living thing.
<b>Harmful action</b>	an action that causes damage to a living thing
<b>Recycling</b>	to change rubbish into a material so it can be used again
