Why do we have jobs?

A: To earn money.

Vocabulary	Definition
jobs	a paid position of regular employment eg. Librarian, IT Programmer, Artist, Dancer, Accountant, Banker, Police
saving	not spending your money straight away, but putting it away so you can spend it later
needs	things that people require to survive eg. food, water, clothing and shelter are all needs
wants	things that a person would like to have but are not needed for survival eg. a want may include a toy, expensive shoes, or the most recent electronics.
money, cash, card, notes, pounds, pence	are all examples of ways to pay for something
interests	the feeling of wanting to know or learn about something or someone.

Arts: musician, dancer, computer games.

Construction: builder, architect, surveyor.

Medicine: Doctor, dentist, vet.
