#### What is a mammal?

An animal that has fur or hair on its body. They also give birth to young.

#### Name some features of amphibians?

They live on land or in water. They do not have scales on their bodies but have webbed feet.

#### Explain what a flightless or swimming bird is and give an example?

Flightless birds do not or cannot fly instead they swim or walk for example penguin, ostrich, and emu.

#### What do animals including humans need to survive?

Food, water, air, appropriate habitat/shelter and for humans – clothing.


#### What are the seven life processes?

Movement, Respiration Sensitivity, Growth, Reproduction, Excretion, Nutrition. (MRS GREN)


#### Name some amphibians and their features?

A toad has dry, bumpy skin. A frog has smooth, moist skin. A newt has a long tail.


- **fish** – an animal with fins, gills and scales that lives in water




- **scales** – small, hard layers that grow from the skin




- **gills** – the part of the body that fish use to breathe



- **bird** – an animal with feathers, wings and a beak




- **reptile** – an animal with dry scales on its body




- **scales** – small, hard layers that grow from the skin

- **amphibian** – an animal that can live on land and in water



- **webbed feet** – feet with toes that are joined together to help with swimming

Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Respiration</b>	breathing- an animal needs to breathe to survive
<b>Reproduction</b>	Animals will have babies of their own.
<b>Nutrition</b>	What an animal eats in order to survive
<b>offspring</b>	The baby of a particular plant or animal e.g. calves – cows, lambs – sheep, seedling – plant, tadpole - frog.
<b>shelter</b>	home or habitat of a living creature
<b>baby</b>	new born human.
<b>Life cycle</b>	The stages a plant or animal goes through to reach adulthood and reproduce.
