

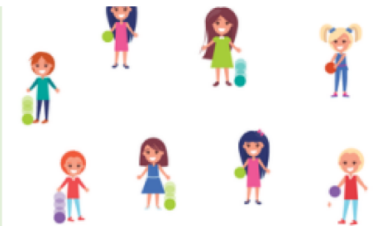

Principles, Tactics, Attacking and Defending

- Dribble effectively into a space by using their feet.
- Use both feet to dribble a ball in a space.
- Avoid collisions with others while dribbling.
- Successfully pass to a teammate in space.
- Trap/receive a pass from a teammate, maintaining control.
- Pass to teammates while avoiding a defender.
- Pass to a teammate and move into another open space.
- Work in a team to maintain possession.
- Able to apply pressure to an attacker to successfully tackle them.
- Able to defend a space to make it difficult for attackers to score.
- Attack a goal/space as an individual/pair/team.
- Pass to a variety of teammates in open spaces.
- Use a wide variety of attacking tactics/skills in small game scenarios.
- Work in a team to defend or attack.



Split the group of 4 into a defender, two attackers and a referee.



Children must dribble their ball around the playing area but must also protect their ball from other players.
