

English - Reading & Writing

This term, children will look at a range of **Fairy Tales, Classic poetry and Newspapers.**

Children will begin by writing their own fairy tale based on ideas from the text 'Pied Piper of Hamelin'. We will be developing our writing using subordinate clauses, fronted adverbials and conjunctions. As part of whole class Reading we will be reading 'Bills New Frock' Written by Anne Fine



Science

Children will identify how sounds are made, associating them with something vibrating. They will recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through the medium to the ear. Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.



Maths

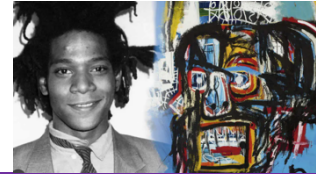
We will continue to develop our **addition and subtraction, and begin to look at measurement involving area.**



It is important that we continue to **expand our Times tables'** knowledge, which will help us in our Multiplication and Division unit of work.

Art

Children will research the artist Jean Basquiat, who was a graffiti. They will design and make a skull printing block to create a print.



Physical Education

Children will perform various exercises improving strength, flexibility and cardio. They will perform exercises in time with music and understand which exercises improve strength. A group of children will be selected to participate with Outdoor and Adventure activities with an instructor.

Computing

In our lessons, we will be continuing to learn about Esafety online and also look at Spreadsheets - exploring formula wizard and formatting cells and discover how we can use a series of data in a spreadsheet to create a line graph.

Geography

History
