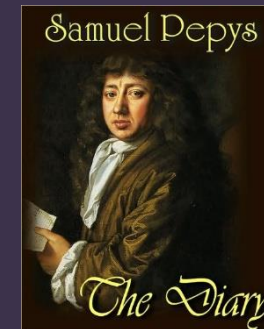
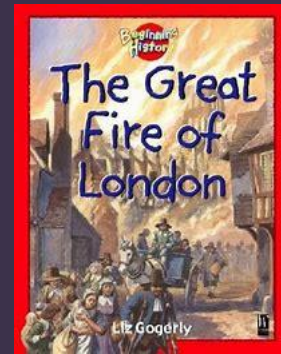

He wrote a diary about the Fire of London.

Vocabulary	Definition
Thatched	A plant material (such as straw) used as a sheltering cover especially of a house.
Timber	House or building made from wood.
Diary	A written record of what has happened through a day or an event.
London	The capital city of the United Kingdom.
Hygiene	The way we care for our bodies, such as washing hands, brushing teeth and bathing.
River Thames	The river that runs through London. The words Thames comes from the ancient name Tamesis which means dark.
Timeline	A line that marks the beginning and end of important events or periods of time.
Comparison	A way of finding out the same and different things between two or more things.
Historical	A study of the past.
