How did Stone Age people live?

Early Stone Age people did not have homes but took shelter in caves or made tents and clothes using animal skins. They travelled to follow the food.

Explain about their diet?

Their diet consisted of nuts, berries, and fruits they gathered and meat and fish that they had hunted using the weapons that they had crafted out of stone and wood.

What is Skara Brae?

Skara Brae is a stone-built Neolithic settlement, thought to have been built around 3000 BC on Orkney, Scotland.

How and why was Stonehenge was created?

Stonehenge is a prehistoric monument in Wiltshire, England. Building started around 5000 years ago. It was thought to have been used for astronomy, religious ceremonies, or places of healing.
