An aerial photograph is a photograph taken from the air.

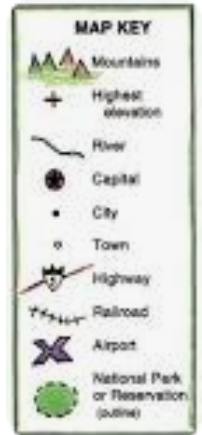
What locational and directional language can you use to describe features and routes on a map?

Key Vocabulary



Vocabulary	Definition
Map	Maps can be drawing or models. They help you find where you are and where you are going.
Symbol	Small pictures that stand for different things on a map.
Key	A map key explains the symbols on the map.
Weather patterns	Weather patterns are when the weather stays the same for periods of time.
Fieldwork	When you go outside and find out things about a place.
Human Feature	City, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbor and shop.
Physical Feature	Beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river,
