END OF KS2 – YEAR 6 RESULTS

The results of the SATs (tests) are reported using a scaled score, where a score of 100 represents the expected standard, and a scaled score of 110 - 120 means that a child is working at a higher level of attainment. The highest possible score is 120 and the lowest is 80.

Children are awarded one of the following Teacher Assessment judgements in writing:
Expected Standard: Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 6.
Greater Depth: Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum.

KS2 PROGRESS

Progress scores for reading, writing and maths will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

*A score of 0 means pupils in the school on average do about as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

*A positive score means pupils in the school on average do better at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally and a negative score means pupils in the school on average do worse at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
