They will also be working on following more than one instruction at a time.</p> 	<p>Communication and Language:</p>  <p>Children will focus on retelling well-known stories, through both repeated phrases and also their own words.</p>	<p>Physical Development:</p>  <p>Children will develop their kicking and tapping skills. They will develop their striking and dribbling with coordination, balance and agility. They will also work on kicking a ball for distance and team building.</p>
<p>Literacy:</p>  <p>This half term, we will be exploring a range of 'Traditional Tales'. Children will continue to learn 'Special Friends' and read words containing them. They will continue to develop their writing through oral rehearsal, counting the words and then pinching the sounds to write. Along with subitising, odd and even and parts and wholes. They will build on addition and subtraction using more and less and finding how many altogether. They will develop sharing and creating groups within numbers.</p>
 <p>Expressive Arts and Design:</p> <p>They will explore colour and colour mixing through shades of colours. They will also be exploring cutting developing their confidence in using scissors. Turning clothes, the right way out, putting shoes on and fastening them. Washing hands Tidying up after themselves. Putting lids on pens.
