

English

This term, we will be reading a range of legends of the British Isles, which will help us to plan and write a legend of our own. In addition, we will produce a formal presentation about a county within the British Isles.



Maths

We will continue to improve our place value and times tables knowledge. In addition, we will use written methods to add and subtract. We will also cover statistics, angles and perimeter.



History

Our topic this term is Anglo-Saxons. We will discover who they were, where they came from and their reasons for invading England. We will produce a timeline and research what it was like to live during that period.



Science

This term we will be learning about the properties of materials and comparing everyday materials. We will carry out comparative and fair tests and use the knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated.



Music

We will be listening to, and performing, a range of music based on the theme of: What shall we do with the drunken sailor? We will look at some musical symbols and terms such as: tempo, pitch and duration.



Computing

Quizzing - This unit introduces children to the process of designing and creating interactive quizzes using Purple Mash's 2Quiz tool. Through exploring question types, adding creative features, and debugging, children will develop their technical skills and creativity while producing engaging quizzes for others to enjoy.



Geography

We will be looking at UK counties, countries, cities and key features using a range of mapping and research tools. We will focus on grid references and identify key human and physical features in a country of the UK.

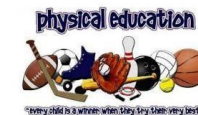


Autumn Term 1 Year 5
