

English

This term, children will look at a range of **Stories with Issues and Dilemmas and Persuasion**. Children will begin by writing their own story with issues and dilemmas based on ideas from the film 'Wallace and Gromit'. We will be developing our writing using subordinate clauses, fronted adverbials for when and where and conjunctions. We will be Reading The Tree House detectives in our Reading Sessions and responding to text by using evidence.



Science

Children explore the digestive system and the route food takes through the body, starting with the teeth. This step introduces children to the oesophagus, stomach, small intestine, large intestine and rectum. Children will be able to define digestion and describe the route taken by food from when it is bitten to when it reaches the rectum. Children are introduced to the enquiry question for this unit and are carrying out a research enquiry.

Art

Children will research the artists P. Cezanne and P. Renoir, who were still life artists. They will design and create a sculpture; make surface patterns and textures on clay using modelling tools.

Mathematics

We will continue to develop our **multiplication and division**, and begin to look at **length involving perimeter**. It is important that we continue to expand our **Times tables'** knowledge, which will help us in our Multiplication and Division unit of work. Children label the fractions on any given number line by identifying the number of intervals between each of the whole numbers.



Computing

In our lessons, we will continue to look at Spreadsheets - exploring formula wizard and begin to study Writing for Different Audiences - explore how font size and style can affect the impact of a text.

Physical Education

During P.E Children will work in teams against other teams in a variety of game situations. They will evaluate and improve their performances in an attempt to outwit their opposition.
