

### Key Vocabulary

<b>sew</b>	to join two pieces together
<b>decorate</b>	to add materials to enhance your design
<b>needle</b>	eye of the needle- hole in the needle to put the thread through
<b>thread</b>	used to sew the fabric together



There are different types of puppets: stick puppets, rod puppets, finger puppets, sock puppets and hand puppets.

### Running Stitch

Running stitch is a line of small even stitches which run back and forth through the cloth without overlapping.

Step 1- Start underneath the fabric and remember to pull until the knot is caught on the bottom side of the fabric

Step 2- In a straight line push the needle back through the fabric so that there is a straight line on the top.

Step 3- When you get to the end, tie a knot close to the fabric.

### HAND PUPPET

- Controlled by the hand or hands that occupies the interior of the puppet.
- Made of cloth, roughly made with head and hand to form glance like hollow structure human face like painting done to look like upper portion body.



Animal puppets- can be used to act out stories or rhymes

### How to make your puppet

- Make sure you have all the materials and tools you need.
- Use a template to cut out the correct shapes of fabric.
- Add decoration and features to the front and back pieces of your puppet.
- Sew or glue the two pieces of your puppet together.
- Tidy up all the materials and tools.
