Key Vocabulary

Vocabulary	Definition
Season	As a year passes, regular changes occur in the weather. This cycle of weather changes is divided into four parts, known as seasons. The four seasons are winter, spring, summer, and autumn.
Weather	Weather is a description of what the conditions are like in a particular place. For example, it could be: hot or cold, wet or dry, windy or calm.
Compass	A compass is a tool which points out directions, such as North, South, East and West. These are also known as the cardinal directions.
Directions	A direction is the line or course along which something moves, lies, or points.
Map	Maps can be drawing or models. They help you find where you are and where you are going.
Symbols and key	Small pictures that stand for different things on a map. A map key explains the symbols on the map.
