

English

This term, children will look at a range of **Stories with a Theme and Information Booklets**. Children will begin by reading and responding to the book **'The Water Horse'** written by M. Murpogo this will **help to write** their own story based on ideas from the book. We will be developing our writing using prepositions and adverbs.



Science - Group and classify living things

Children will identify and sort animals into groups based on their features. Children identify and name familiar animals from insect, spider and soft-bodied invertebrate groups. Children group animals based on easily identifiable features.



Maths

We will continue to develop our **number and decimals**, and begin to look at **measurement**, involving **money and time**. It is important that we continue to expand our **Multiplication Facts** knowledge, which will help us in our **Multiplication and Division** unit of work.

Children will create an Egyptian profile drawing/painting inspired by hieroglyphics onto papyrus paper.
