A: Having a variety of perspectives, people, backgrounds, skin colour, language, age, sex in a group or community. Diversity involves having people from a variety of cultural, ethnic and racial backgrounds, different perspectives, and differences in characteristics of humans.

What do the British Values of 'Mutual Respect' 'Tolerance' and 'Individual Liberty' mean?

A: Mutual Respect: "everyone being valued for who they are" Tolerance: "allowing opinions or behaviour that may be different to own." 'Individual Liberty': "The right to believe, act and express oneself freely."
