

Literacy



The children will read The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch and write their own version. They will learn about explanations and write their own explanation text connected to the seaside. They will also look at poems about the seaside.

Numeracy

The children will be learning about time and how to tell the time including solving problems. They will also learn about position and direction. In addition they will develop their understanding of bar graphs, tally charts and pictograms.

Religious Education



The children will learn about ascension and Pentecost linked to Christianity. They will learn about when Jesus ascended to heaven and the creation of the church as well as the events that took place for Pentecost.

Science

Children will learn about living things and their habitats. They will be learning about different habitats and how animals and plants survive there. In addition they will learn about microhabitats and explore these in detail.

History



Children will learn about how people in the Victorian era discovered holidays at the seaside. They will also learn about Blackpool now and Blackpool 100 years ago.

Computing

The children will be developing their understanding of using a computer programme to create pictures. They will be using 2 Paint and will use the programme to investigate a range of tools and to create a variety of pictures.

Art and Design Technology

Children will develop art work related to the seaside and create their own beach scenes after looking at the work of Serena Hall and Jayne Huskisson. They will develop their knowledge of colour, shape and texture.
