What is S. Hall's style?

Serena's creates backgrounds to her art work using screen printing and mono printing.

What techniques will we use?

Experiment with different backgrounds creating a collage by layering.

What technique does Serena Hall use?

Broad brushstrokes and vibrant colour. Serena's paintings resonate energy and light. Her style is very distinctive using a self-developed technique of layering hand-dyed printed cottons.

Vocabulary	Definition
Tone	Tone refers to how light or dark something is. Tones could refer to black, white and the grey tones in-between.
Textures	Texture refers to how something feels, including its appearance and consistency. Texture in art concerns the surface quality of a piece of work.
Patterns	A design in which lines, shapes, forms or colours are repeated. In art, patterns are used to organise and decorate designs,
Textiles	A textile is something made by knitting, weaving, or crocheting fibres together.
Collage	A collage is a piece of art made from different pieces of paper, photos and other materials.
Surface	A surface is the top layer of something.
