

### English

Our class novel this term will be **Journey to the River Sea**, as we will be studying **Stories from Other Cultures**. We will continue to have a grammar focus to each lesson. We will also be focussing on spelling - using the spelling patterns and rules,



### Maths

We will continue to look at: **perimeter, area and statistics**. We will also look at **shapes** - lengths, angles and regular and irregular polygons. Together with **position and directions**, which will enable children to read and plot coordinates, look at translation and lines of symmetry.



### French

Children will be looking at writing a description of themselves in French.



### Art

We will be looking at the work of **Ruth Daniels** and **Henri Rousseau** experimenting with watercolours and computer media to produce a rainforest painting.



### Religious Education

We will be looking at the topic **People of faith**: how does having faith affect people's lives? We will be focussing on the religions **Christianity and Buddhism**

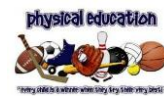

### Physical Education

Children will be taking part in lessons focussing on **how to be a team player**. They will be understanding the law of games, targeting and physical challenges.



### Geography

In keeping with our topic, we will be studying the geography of the **Amazon Basin** and the areas surrounding the tropical rainforest.



### Personal, Social and Health Education:

The topic this term is 'How can drugs common to everyday life affect health?'



### Science

In Science, we will be exploring **life cycles** and will produce a nature journal that documents the life cycle of one animal and two plants.



### Design Technology

We will research, design and make an apron with pockets focussing on **textile making skills**. Children will design a pattern, cut the materials using the pattern, sew the material together and try out their apron.



### Computing

We will be looking at 3D modelling - exploring designing for a purpose in 3D, looking at moving parts and editing and printing a model.
