Please find a selection of activities that you can enjoy doing with your child while at home. All of these activities link to our learning happening in Nursery.

Animal Sounds Game

Say an animal (cow, sheep, chicken) and your child makes the sound.

2Feed the Toy Animals (Counting)

Use any toys (or even drawings on paper). Give them small items like raisins, cereal, or pasta to "feed" (e.g., 2 for the cow, 3 for the sheep).

Simple Farm Drawing

Ask your child to draw a farm using crayons or pencils.

Sort Food from the Kitchen

Pick 3-4 foods (like apples, carrots, potatoes).

Find Animal Pairs (Memory Game)

Draw simple animals twice on paper (or say them aloud). Match or remember pairs like cow-cow, pig-pig.

Talk About a Farm Story. Read any book (doesn't have to be farm-themed). Just ask: "What animals might live on a farm?"

Pretend Farm Play Use anything—blocks, spoons, boxes. Pretend one is a tractor, others are animals.

Farmer Jobs Chat

Have a simple conversation:
"What do farmers do?" "Who gives us milk?"
