

English

This term, we will focus on Short Stories with Flashbacks, Discussion and Debate and Classic Narrative Poetry. There will be a particular focus on responding to writing and writing for an audience adopting the appropriate style. Children will be given ample opportunities to write independently in genres of their choice.



Mathematics

This term, key learning will recap and build on all areas of Maths: addition and subtraction, fractions, decimals and percentages, algebra, measurement, and statistics. There will be a greater focus on data collection linked to Science, History and Geography. Children will learn to collate data for a questionnaire and then analyse it.

Science

Living Things and Their Habitats:

Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including microorganisms, plants and animals.

Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

Physical Education

This term, we will focus on Netball. Through the teaching of this sport, we will learn to apply basic principles of team work to keep possession of the ball, improve our passing, dribbling, and shooting with accuracy. Other skills we will develop are making decisions quickly, defending skills to mark an opponent or defend their goal.



Personal, Social and Health Education

This term, children will learn what will change as we become more independent? How do friendships change as we grow? We will learn about independence and how it comes with increased opportunities and responsibilities. We will also explore how friendships change over time.
